**RESPONSIBILITIES:** Collects, analyzes and interprets social, economic, and engineering data for planning and community development programs; prepares digital maps, tables and charts. Prepares reports, plans and strategies regarding urban and community issues; prepares cases for the Plan Board, Board of Zoning Appeals and Landmarks Commission. Works as a team member with a wide variety of neighborhood and community groups, City staff and agencies. The incumbent must have a working knowledge of Geographic Information Systems; use of ESRI products is desired. Prepares plans and guidelines for improving the city's physical environment in order to promote optimum utilization of land and acceptable designs of structures and neighborhoods.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Bachelor's or Master's degree in Planning, Urban and Regional Studies, Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Historic Preservation, Geography, Public Administration, or a related field. Degree must be from a college or university that is accredited by the U.S. Department of Education through the North Central Association of Colleges and Universities or equivalent region. Must possess a valid driver's license at time of appointment and maintain thereafter as a term and condition of continued employment.

Applications must specifically address each of the minimum qualifications, directly showing how each is met.

**Your online application must be submitted by August 25, 2014.** A complete position description may be obtained from the Civil Service Board Office.

### GENERAL EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS

Final permanent appointment is contingent upon the applicant passing a job-related medical examination, including drug screen, and providing documentary evidence of Employment Authorization and Identity.
